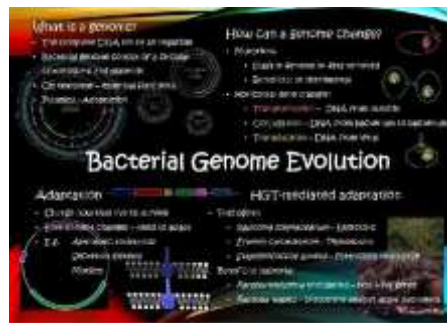
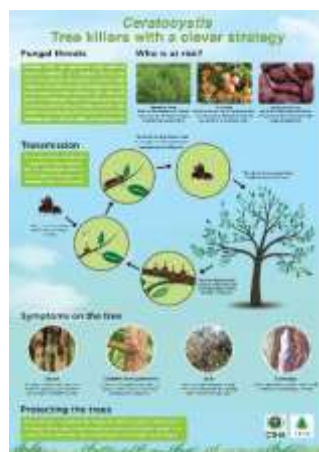
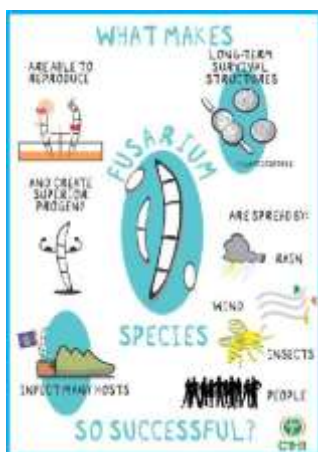


FOUR STUDENTS BAG CASH PRIZES FOR ORIGINAL POSTER DESIGNS
